#### **PROCEDURES**

#### The Venturer applying for a scholarship should:

- Complete the application personally.
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements (no biographies, resumes, or supplementary lists of activities). Items should not be stapled to the application. (Please use paperclips)
- Answer all questions on the application. ("See attached" is not an acceptable answer.)
- Please try to limit your entry to fewer than 10 pages with the application (i.e., financial statement, recommendation, and high school transcript).
- Include the applicant's name on each enclosure in the upper right hand corner
- Submit all supplemental information with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time. (The Northern Star Scouting cannot assume responsibility for matching items that come in separately.)

- Applications <u>must</u> be received no later than 11:59 p.m. on February 27, 2023 to be considered.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

#### All applicants must:

- Be currently registered as a youth with Northern Star Scouting in the Venturing Program.
- Have not been awarded another Scholarship from Northern Star Scouting
- Provide a transcript of school grades covering prior semesters only.
   The transcript need not be "official".
- Be a graduating High School Senior entering a post secondary school or a Freshman enrolled in college in the year the scholarship is awarded.
- Submit photocopy of ACT and/or SAT score unless score is included on transcript.
- Have demonstrated leadership ability in Venturing and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Venturing; and
- \*(1) Provide a statement by the applicant clearly stating why they
  believe they need financial aid, signed by the applicant and
  countersigned by the parent.
- \*(2) Provide one signed recommendation letter from a volunteer Venturing leader or a professional Scouter who knows the applicant personally. This is the only endorsement required. Endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc., should not be included.
- \*(3) Attach a brief statement of 50 to 100 words entitled, "What receiving this Venturing Scholarship would mean to me."

Scholarship funds will be held in escrow and sent directly to the financial officer at the school of your choice. When the Escrow Release form is received by the Northern Star Scouting, your scholarship funds will be forwarded with a statement to the school's financial officer indicating that these funds must be used as the recipient directs and may not be used to reduce the financial grants provided by the school.
