



2020 Northern Star Facial Covering Exemption Form

(To be completed by only those with a Medical Exemption for wearing facial coverings)

In accordance with the executive orders issued in the states of Minnesota and Wisconsin, facial coverings are required in indoor public spaces and outdoors when social distancing of 6 feet cannot be maintained.

This would be understood by Northern Star Council to include all Scouting activities and facilities.

Exemptions from wearing facial coverings are provided in both executive orders for individuals whose medical or psychological condition would cause a breathing impairment.

In those instances of exemption, an individual's involvement in Scouting programming may be limited if 6-foot social distancing cannot be maintained or space requirements cannot ensure the proper air flow necessary to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission by airborne respiratory droplets.

By signing below:

- I attest that I or my child have a confirmed medical or psychological condition that triggers a breathing impairment when wearing a facial covering.
- I understand that my involvement in Scouting programming may be limited if I am not able to wear a mask, a face shield or other facial covering, and if room size or airflow are insufficient.
- Medical documentation is not required.
- I acknowledge the Scout law and its tenets to be honest, trustworthy, kind, obedient and cheerful.
