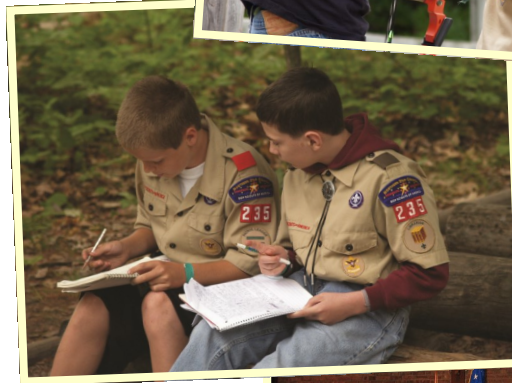

What is the James E. West Fellowship?

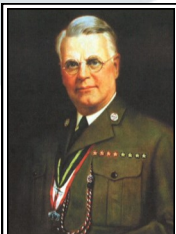
The James E. West Fellowship Award is a recognition authorized by the National Council, B.S.A. and presented by Northern Star Council to those who contribute **\$1,000 or more** to Northern Star Council's **endowment fund** through a West Fellowship.



Such contributions are in addition to, not instead of, the donor's annual gift to Scouting.

Who was James E. West?

James E. West was the first Chief Scout Executive of the Boy Scouts of America. West's thirty-plus years of energy and leadership are largely responsible for developing the structure and momentum that Scouting has today.

Who can become a West Fellow?

Individuals may make a qualifying contribution on their own or in honor of another. Honorees can include Eagle Scouts, departed loved ones, or anyone who demonstrates West's energy and leadership for youth development.



Those recognized with a West Fellowship create their own legacy for future generations of Scouts in Northern Star Council.

How is the West Fellowship recognized?

The West Fellowship is recognized with a personalized 8x10 inch certificate, a distinctive lapel pin and an embroidered square knot. The recognition is immediate and is presented after a donor pledges his or her fellowship gift. While full and immediate gifts are preferred, donors may pay over a 3-year period.
